

Attendance and participation: Classes are conducted in a discussion/workshop format and depend on your active learning. Therefore, regular attendance and productive, courteous participation with classmates and the instructor are important. Absences damage your grade and too many may result in you having to drop the course. To ensure that you stay on track with your attendance and assignments, the following policies will be enforced in all sections of English for Media Communication:

- 1 missed class= 0.5 point from the 15 points in the "Class work" grade
- Working out a missed class = watching a 20 mnt video, learn 10 new words and write a short summary (5-6 sentences) on the video

Grading and evaluation: While it is assumed that students admitted to the university can perform satisfactorily most of the time, earning *As* and *Bs* will require strong, consistent effort. To make sure you know what is expected, you should read all assignment sheets carefully, especially the evaluation criteria, and pay close attention to the feedback you receive. Start assignments early and work steadily to avoid last-minute rushing.
